<b>Blue-White Screening (Terminal Integrity)</b> - A sample of pUC19 vector linearized with a 10-fold excess of SphI, religated and transformed into an <i>E. coli</i> strain expressing the LacZ beta fragment gene results in <1% white colonies.	Pass
<b>Endonuclease Activity (Nicking)</b> - A 50 $\mu$ l reaction in NEBuffer 2.1 containing 1 $\mu$ g of supercoiled PhiX174 DNA and a minimum of 30 Units of SphI incubated for 4 hours at 37°C results in <20% conversion to the nicked form as determined by agarose gel electrophoresis.	Pass
<b>Exonuclease Activity (Radioactivity Release)</b> - A 50 $\mu$ l reaction in NEBuffer 2.1 containing 1 $\mu$ g of a mixture of single and double-stranded [ <sup>3</sup> H] <i>E. coli</i> DNA and a minimum of 100 units of SphI incubated for 4 hours at 37°C releases <0.1% of the total radioactivity.	Pass
<b>Ligation and Recutting (Terminal Integrity)</b> - After a 10-fold over-digestion of Lambda DNA with SphI, >95% of the DNA fragments can be ligated with T4 DNA ligase in 16 hours at 16°C. Of these ligated fragments, >95% can be recut with SphI.	Pass
<b>Non-Specific DNase Activity (16 hour)</b> - A 50 $\mu$ l reaction in NEBuffer 2.1 containing 1 $\mu$ g of Lambda DNA and a minimum of 10 Units of SphI incubated for 16 hours at 37°C results in a DNA pattern free of detectable nuclease degradation as determined by agarose gel electrophoresis. NOTE: although no nuclease degradation is detected under these conditions, extended incubations and/or high concentrations of this enzyme may result in star activity.
