Antibiotic Resistance (Nitrofurantoin) - 15 µl of untransformed SHuffle® Express Competent *E. coli* streaked onto a LB or Rich Broth plate containing Nitrofurantoin will form colonies after incubation for 16 hours at 37°C.

Antibiotic Resistance (Spectinomycin) - 15 µl of untransformed SHuffle® Express Competent *E. coli* streaked onto a LB or Rich Broth plate containing Spectinomycin will form colonies after incubation for 16 hours at 37°C.

Antibiotic Resistance (Streptomycin) -  $15 \mu l$  of untransformed SHuffle® Express Competent *E. coli* streaked onto a LB or Rich Broth plate containing Streptomycin will form colonies after incubation for 16 hours at 37°C.

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Transformation Efficiency - 50  $\mu$ l of SHuffle® Express Competent *E. coli* cells were transformed with 100 pg of pUC19 DNA using the transformation protocol provided. Incubation overnight on LB-Ampicillin plates at 37°C resulted in >1 x 10e7 cfu/ $\mu$ g of DNA.
