Assay Name/Specification (minimum release criteria)

Exonuclease Activity (Radioactivity Release) - A 50 μ l reaction in CutSmartTM Buffer containing 1 μ g of a mixture of single and doublestranded [³H] *E. coli* DNA and a minimum of 50 units of Tth1111 incubated for 4 hours at 65°C releases <0.1% of the total radioactivity.

Ligation and Recutting (Terminal Integrity) - After a 5-fold over-digestion of pBC4 DNA with Tth1111, \sim 25% of the DNA fragments can be ligated with T4 DNA ligase in 16 hours at 16°C. Of these ligated fragments, >95% can be recut with Tth1111.

Non-Specific DNase Activity (16 hour) - A 50 μ l reaction in CutSmartTM Buffer containing 1 μ g of pBC4 DNA and a minimum of 5 units of Tth1111 incubated for 16 hours at 65°C results in a DNA pattern free of detectable nuclease degradation as determined by agarose gel electrophoresis. NOTE: although no nuclease degradation is detected under these conditions, extended incubations and/or high concentrations of this enzyme may result in star activity. See the product FAQ for recommended reaction conditions for this enzyme.

Protein Purity Assay (SDS-PAGE) - Tth1111 is >95% pure as determined by SDS PAGE analysis using Coomassie Blue detection.
