Exonuclease Activity (Radioactivity Release) - A 50  $\mu$ l reaction in CutSmart<sup>TM</sup> Buffer containing 1  $\mu$ g of a mixture of single and double-stranded [  $^3$ H] *E. coli* DNA and a minimum of 100 units of BfaI incubated for 4 hours at 37°C releases <0.1% of the total radioactivity.
