Functional Testing (Dephosphorylation) A 23 µl reaction in Antarctic Phosphatase Reaction Buffer containing 1 µg of linear DNA with 5' recessed ends and 1 unit of Antarctic Phosphatase incubated for 30 minutes at 37°C results in ≥95% dephosphorylation as measured by transformation into <i>E. coli</i> . Endonuclease Activity (Nicking, Buffer) A 50 µl reaction in 1X Antarctic Phosphatase Reaction Buffer containing 1 µg of supercoiled PhiX174 DNA incubated for 4 hours at 37°C results in <10% conversion to the nicked form as determined by agarose gel electrophoresis.	Pass
